Based on Article 13. and Article 30. of the Law on Tourist Board (Official Gazette of Tuzla Canton No. 11/15), Article 18. and Article 33. Point 1. of the Statute of the Tuzla Canton Tourist Board (Official Gazette of Tuzla Canton No. 5/17), the Tuzla Canton Tourist Board at the session held on January 29, 2024.; **declares:**

**PUBLIC CALL
FOR EXPRESSING INTEREST IN SUBSIDIZING AIR TRAFFIC BY DEVELOPING
EXISTING AND/OR ESTABLISHING ADDITIONAL AIRLINES IN TUZLA
CANTON**

I THE SUBJECT OF THE PUBLIC CALL

The subject of the public call is the expressing of interest in subsidizing air traffic through the development of existing and/or the establishment of additional air routes in Tuzla Canton from Tuzla International Airport with the purpose of tourism development.

The Public Call for expression of interest in subsidizing air traffic through the development of existing and/or the establishment of additional air routes in Tuzla Canton (hereinafter: Public Call) determines the goal, capacity and planned scope of operations, with the purpose of developing air traffic and increasing number of passengers in Tuzla Canton.

II OBJECTIVE OF THE PUBLIC CALL

The goal of the Public Call is development of tourism and air traffic in Tuzla Canton in 2024 by expressing the interest of airlines in order to retain existing or establish new destinations, increase the number of passengers, as well as to improve the tourism sector.

III AMOUNT OF FUNDS

After the end of the Public Call and establishment of the required amount, the subsidy funds will be secured in the Budget of Tuzla Canton Tourist Board through the Ministry of Trade, Tourism and Transport of Tuzla Canton with the purpose of "Current transfers to the Tourist Board of Tuzla Canton for co-financing of projects of importance for the development of tourism" based on the program passed and approved by the Government of Tuzla canton.

IV THE RIGHT TO APPLY TO THE PUBLIC CALL

The right to apply for the Public Call have all airlines that plan to establish new air routes and/or develop existing ones, and that meet the following conditions:

1. have an Operating Permit of the Operator (Operation license);
2. have a valid Air Operator's Certificate (AOC);
3. have an established system of "online" sales of airline tickets and ancillary services.

V MANDATORY DOCUMENTATION

In order to apply to the Public Call, an airline must submit the following documentation:

1. Operating Permit of the Operator (Operation license);
2. Airline Operator's Certificate (AOC);
3. Current extract from the court register or an equivalent document depending on the country in which the airline is registered;
4. Response plan in case of aircraft inoperability;
5. Statement by which the bidder confirms that it has an established system of "online" sales of airline tickets and ancillary services;
6. Completed offer form contained in Annex 1 of the Public Call.

Aircompany are responsible for the accuracy and completeness of the attached documentation, and that all submitted documents are valid and relevant for the evaluation of their application.

VI SELECTION CRITERIA

The criteria for choosing one or more airlines are as follows:

1. An airplane with a minimum capacity of 110 seats;
2. Lowest price per rotation.

VII APPLICATION TO THE PUBLIC CALL

Offers in reference to this Public Call shall be submitted electronically to the e-mail address turzajtk@bih.net.ba no later than 7 days from the date of publication of the Notice of the Public Call in the daily newspaper. The text of the Public Call will be simultaneously published on the official websites www.tourism-tk.ba and www.tuzla-airport.ba

In addition to the obligation to send the offer by e-mail, airlines are also obliged to send the original offer to the address:

no later than within an additional 5 days after the deadline for submitting the offer electronically.

An offer submitted after the specified deadline, regardless of the delivery method, will not be considered and will be returned to the bidder unopened.
